



## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT PROCESS

### Articulated Credit Criteria:

- Student must complete the entire program
- Student must have a “B” or better in articulated course
- Student may earn maximum of 12 credit hours

### Admission to Stark State College (SSC) - The student must:

- Complete the college application [www.starkstate.edu/admissions](http://www.starkstate.edu/admissions)
- Obtain Articulation Agreement from College Tech Prep teacher, Guidance Counselor, SCCTP office, or SCCTP website at [www.starkcountyttechprep.org](http://www.starkcountyttechprep.org)
- Fill out student section of articulation agreement
- Turn in to College Tech Prep Teacher
- Complete the COMPASS Test/or ACT
- Submit a high school transcript to:

- Attend at least one class at SSC to receive credits (Dual Credit/Postsecondary option apply)
- Apply for financial aid prior to start of semester
- Business and Interactive Media majors must schedule interview with appropriate division to receive articulated credit.

### Transferability of Credit to Other Post Secondary Institutions:

- Complete Articulation Agreement-Student will have to take at least one course at SSC to transfer articulated credit. (Dual credit/Post Secondary option apply)

### College Tech Prep Teacher Must:

- Initial the course next to course which students are receiving articulated credit and/or test-out
- Assign grade to course(s)
