

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into by and between MALONE COLLEGE ("College") and MASSILLON CITY SCHOOL DISCTRICT ("School").

The College has agreed to cooperate with the School in articulating course credit for College EDUC 112 ("Foundations of Education") for any student who successfully completes course requirements and assignments for Massillon Washington High School's Career Paths for the Teaching Professions two-year program and who is admitted as a student in good standing to the College.

School faculty shall be responsible for:

Verifying and recommending School's students who have successfully met all of the following requirements:

- A. Maintained at least a "B" average in their "Career Paths for the Teaching Professions" course of study.
- B. Completed Career Assessment Inventory (at College expense) and Reflection Paper per College EDUC 112 requirements.
- C. Completed Philosophy of Education Paper per College EDUC 112 requirements.

For School students admitted in good standing and upon verification of the above, the College will grant petition credit for College EDUC 112.

This agreement may be terminated by either party with a thirty (30) day written notice, upon making satisfactory provision for School's students participating under this Agreement.
