Upon review of the curricula of the Wayne County Joint Vocational High School Practical Nursing Program and the Wayne Adult School of Practical Nursing, it is agreed that graduates (Licensed Practical Nurses) from either of these Programs will be given advanced credit towards an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) at Stark State College of Technology.

Based upon satisfactory completion of all prerequisite courses and testing, as outlined in the Stark State College of Technology Associate Degree in Nursing Program admission criteria for the Licensed Practical Nurse, students will be admitted as space is available for the summer Transition for the LPN-(NUR201) course. Upon successful completion of this course, Transition for the LPN-(NUR201), students will be eligible to enter the Fall Semester of the second level of the nursing program. Students will follow all policies and procedures as outlined by the Associate Degree in Nursing Program at Stark State College of Technology.
